Notes:

1. The Superintendent's Standards ("S") are derived from the Low Income Cutoffs (LICO) released by Statistics Canada. The Superintendent uses the before-tax LICO for urban areas with 500,000 people and over. The 2011 standards are updated by adding to the 2009 LICO, the 2010 Consumer Price Index (CPI) (1.84%) plus a 2.1% adjustment reflecting the 2011 CPI expectation.
2. The amounts shown in the table represent the total monthly surplus income of the bankrupt over the standards. The surplus income payment to the trustee is 50% of this amount.
